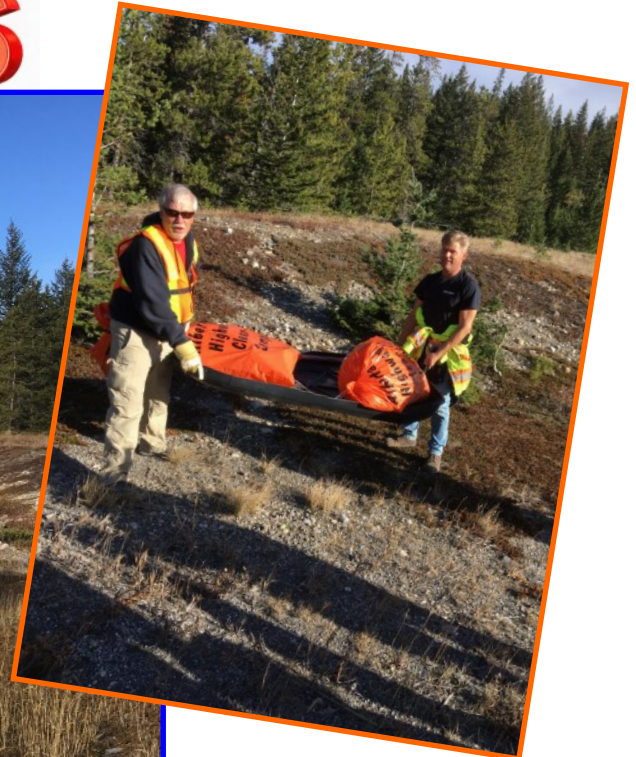


AMAC Highway Cleanup

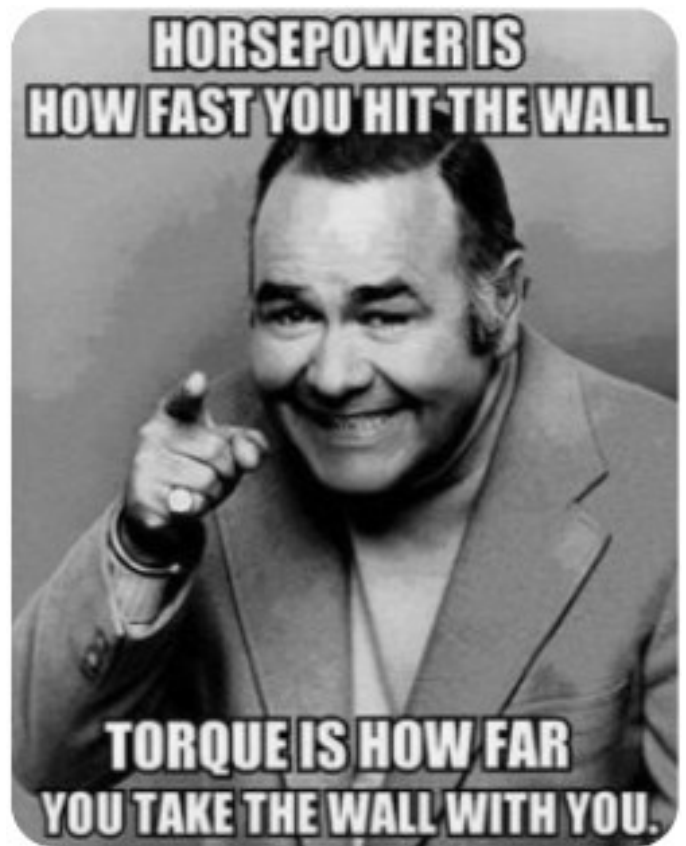

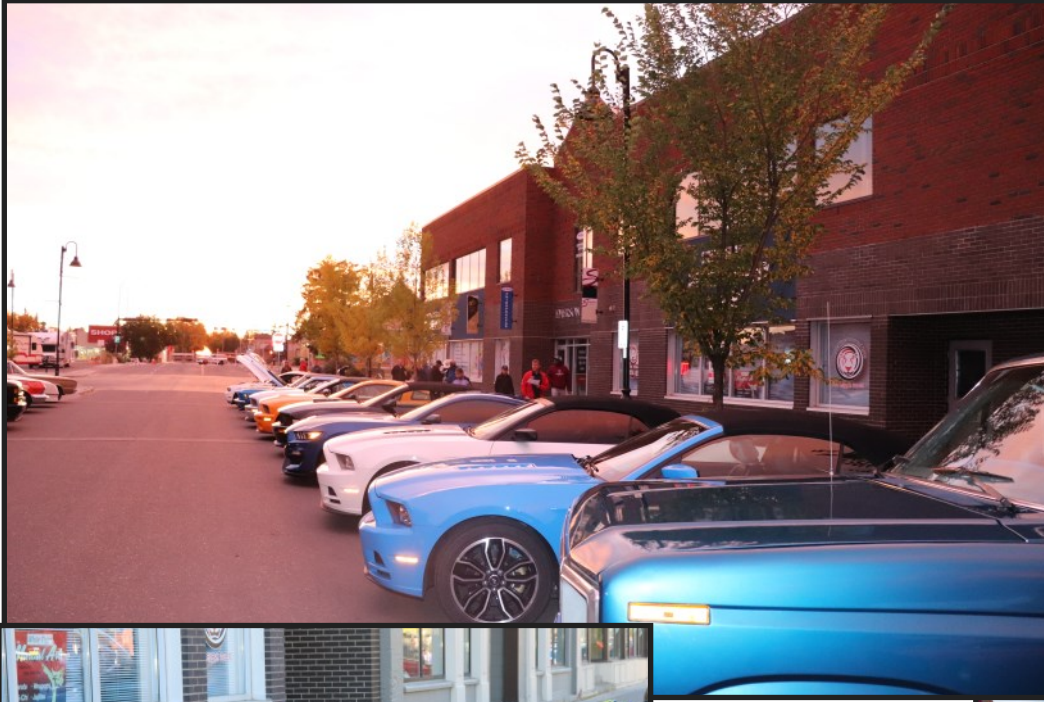
