

# TRANNY SWAP

We bought our 88 Fox a couple years ago at the Okotoks Collector Car Auction even though it was sporting the original AOD automatic transmission. There is absolutely nothing wrong with an automatic transmission, and is quite possibly what saved this car from the fate that occurred to most of the manual Fox bodies of this vintage. Fast forward to today, and all the worlds fastest cars no longer contain manuals, and it does appear that the trend will continue. However, that AOD did not provide the nostalgic feeling of banging gears off in a Fox body that we remembered so vividly. There is something magical about the mechanical feeling of the T5 with its clutch cable, long throw, and ever present slight gear whine and the NVH that comes through that shift handle. Much like a toploader, it sets the whole characteristic of the car.

We were facing with a dilemma though. Should you trans swap a 32 year old, 100% original car? With Foxes suddenly being in the limelight and having their day in the sun, would swapping out the trans hurt the originality and value? Ford produced over 2.6 million Fox body Mustangs from 1979-1993, with over 120,000 3 door hatches being produced in 1988 alone. So, no, a stock AOD equipped Fox is nothing rare, or something that must be saved, at least in my opinion today. Now, if it was a McLaren M81, SVT Cobra R, or one of the special editions like a 7-UP or summer edition. that would be a totally different discussion. One would note too, that most of the most sought-after Foxes only came with manuals. So yeah, it may not be the course of action that a purist would take, but there was little chance that a purist, or serious collector was was in the market for an all stock 8 Mustang GT. So let's swap that sucker!

First of any project though is finding the parts. One would think that after building 2.6 million of these, parts would be everywhere. However, thats not the case for a manual swap due to the amount of parts required. You can buy them all brand new, but with a price tag of about \$3800 US, it was too steep to go this route, and we are looking for used parts out of a donor car. Fortunately for us, a member of AMAC's Facebook page posted that they were looking for a complete swap kit, and a member from Camrose Alberta replied they had all the parts from a '87 car they were willing to sell. After discussions between the two, the original poster decided it was too expensive and far to travel to purchase, and we were able to obtain the complete parts list, which included the T5, bell housing, driveshaft, flywheel, clutch fork, shifter cable, wiring harness, shifter, boot, pedals and console plate. While it came with a clutch and pressure plate too, this is one the parts that was replaced with a new McLeod units.

While the swap itself is essentially easy as all the parts were designed for that car, it is not for the faint of heart. We could not believe how much has to be disassembled to swap the parts, with the pedals being the most difficult. Most of the interior has to come part to get the steering shaft out so the pedals can be removed. We had a couple "uh oh, what have we done moments" especially after being showered with ATF when the torque converter slid off the shaft when removing the 200-lb boat anchor AOD, or when even armed with extensive amount of wobble extensions and swivels you just cannot quite get that one last bolt, and when you finally did, it broke. Stupid exhaust manifolds!

However, after a couple weeks a evening garage frustrations, it was complete and fully assembled. First test was of the clutch neutral safety switch, and the back up lights, and we're happy to report they worked perfectly the very first time, although

the clutch engagement is going to take a little more tweaking. Silly cables!

So enjoy the few pics of the mayhem that occurred, and we can't wait to see you all out there, including the projects that you finished over the winter/covid shut down!
