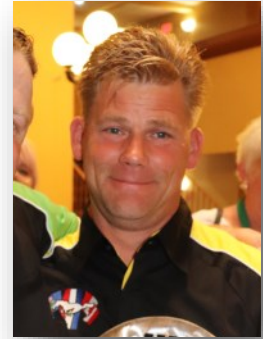

BEV BLIGH

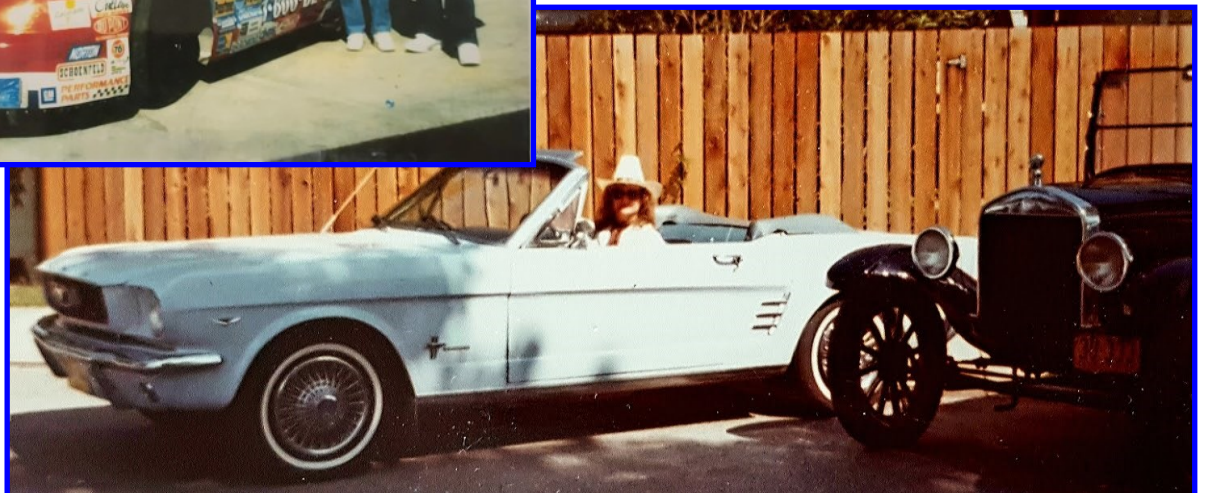
1950—2023



Bev and her husband Wayne were early members of AMAC and active for many years. Bev was one of the signatories when AMAC filed their Societies Act of Alberta paperwork back in 1980. She also served as President in the early '90's. They attended many of the earlier IMMs.

Wayne and Bev owned many Mustangs and other Fords over the years. A couple of their cars included a 1966 Hertz Mustang and a 1969 Shelby GT350 Fastback. Both of these cars now reside in GVMA (Vancouver) members' garages in the Lower Mainland.

They had not been active in our Club for multiple years, but they did make an appearance at IMM 37 at Grey Eagle the one afternoon and would come out to the High River shows in September. *Russ Penner*





I joined AMAC in 1990, I believe Bev was the president of the club then as I can remember her on stage during the introductions at 1990 IMM .

I was over to Wayne and Bev's home a couple of times where they were both helpful and friendly towards myself being a new member. I learned of Bev's coming down with MS when I asked why she sold her fox body convertible. I was told it was because she could not use the clutch any more.

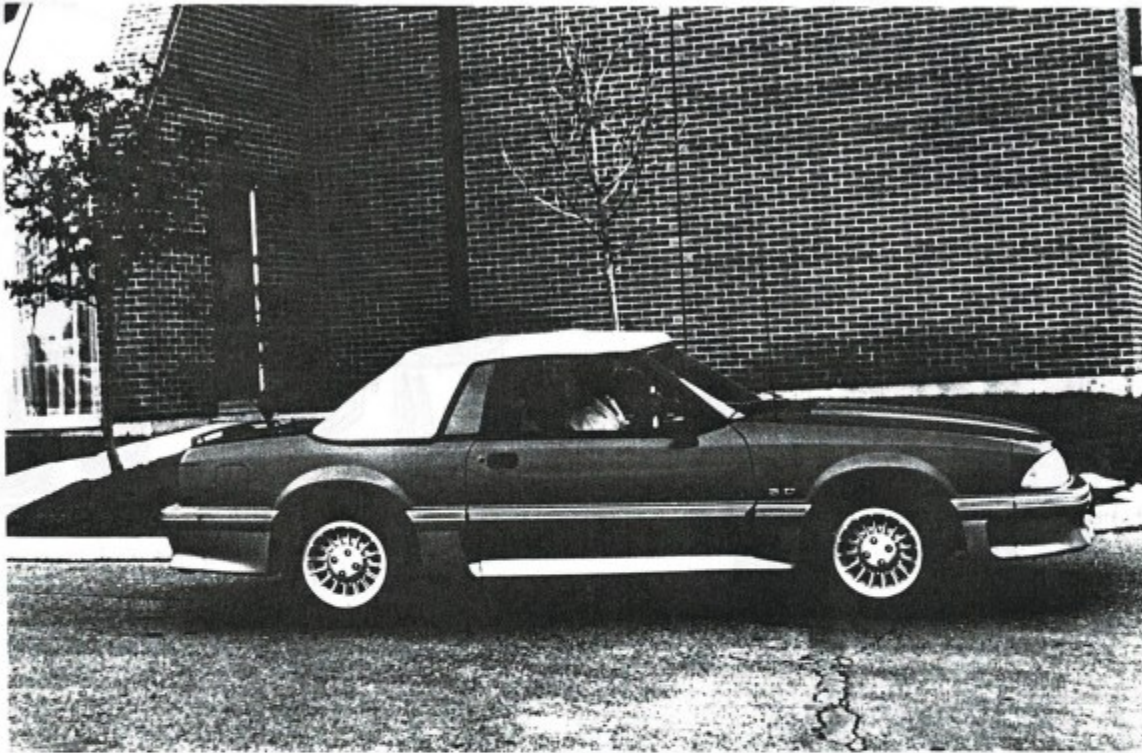

Their thoughts were to keep her muscles in shape in case there was a cure for MS. By this time Bev was in a wheel chair, and always had a care person with her and Wayne. 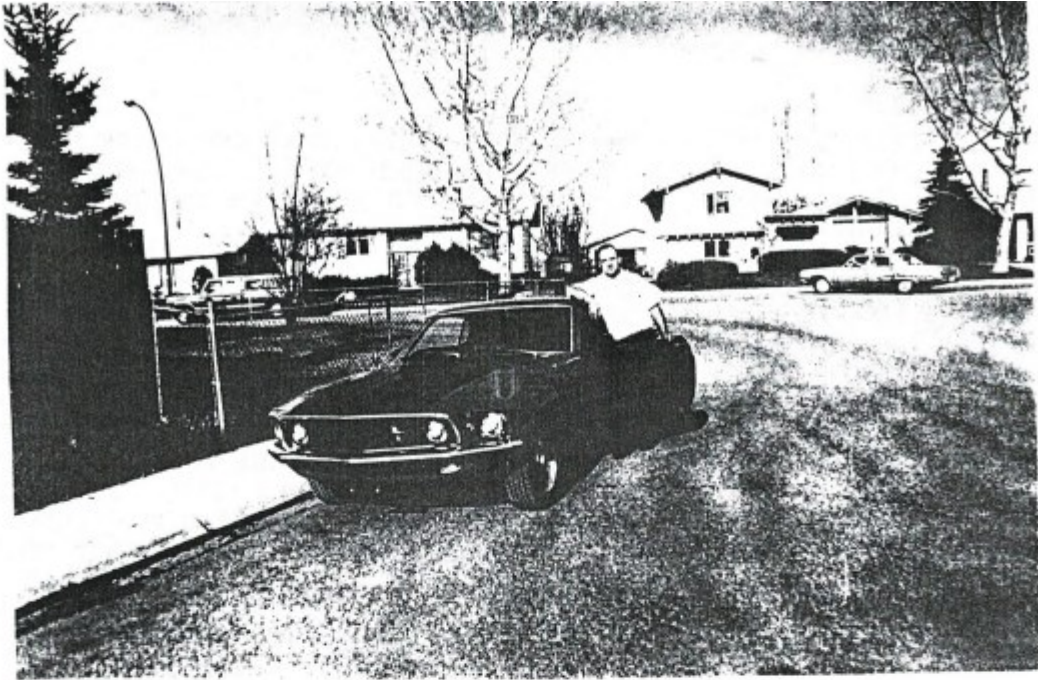


**OWNER: BEV BLIGH

The 5.0 litre H.O. is backed up with a automatic overdrive transmission and has all the options. Cloth seats are easy to keep clean and are nice and gentle on a person on hot summer days. We have 20,000 km. on the car to date, as it is used as a daily driver (weather permitting), not good on ice and snow.

Those who remember 1990 can also recall our first lady president, and most likely her procrastinating husband. As the story goes, Bev and her husband disassembled her 64 1/2 convertible a few years before so that a proper restoration would take place.

Now her husband having a conscience felt it only proper that the president kept up appearances in a vintage mustang. (Bev at this time terrorizing the likes of Camero's with an early 5 litre H O convertible). Always wanting an orange sports car an add in the Herald caught my attention this one spring morning.

1969 mustang mach 1, orange exterior and black interior \$-----.
Just what the Doctor ordered. Bev would learn to like orange.

The chap that sold us the car had replaced the big block with a small block 302 back when the first gas crunch hit 79/80's.

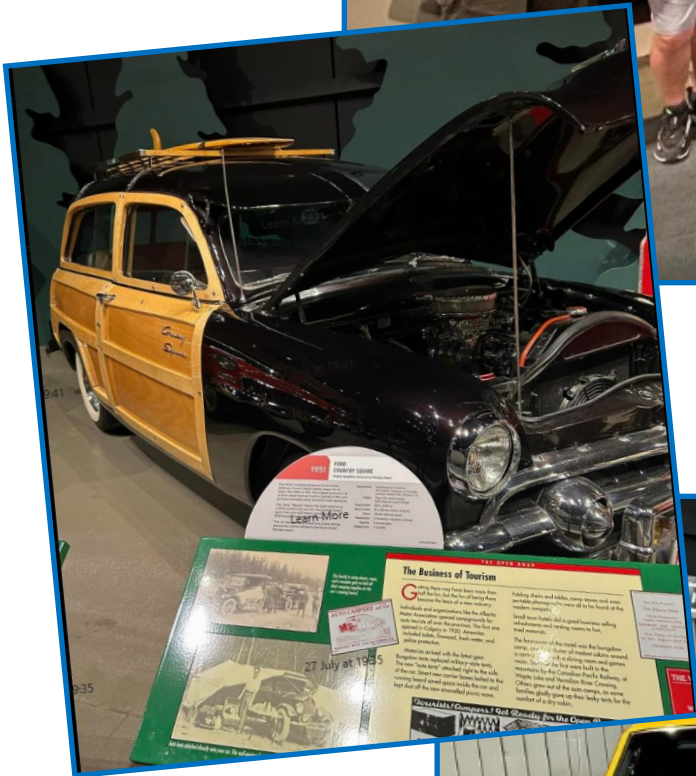

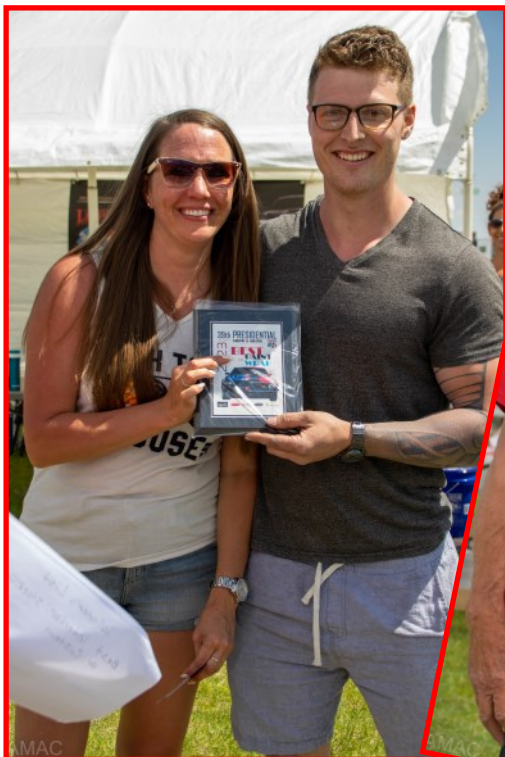

AMAC MEMBER DON MCLEOD 1945 — 2023

Don was one of our newer AMAC members, he joined a couple of years ago and was pretty active in the club. Although he was obviously camera shy as I could only find one photo of him in our club cache. I'm sure many of you remember chatting with Don, he was a friendly guy.

Don McLeod passed away suddenly on July 8, 2023, at the age of 77 years. He was born in Calgary and lived in the city for most of his life. After completing his Bachelor of Commerce degree at the University of Alberta in 1967, Don took a job in Saskatoon. He met his future wife, Judy, while living in Saskatoon and they were married in 1973. Don and Judy moved to Calgary one year later, where they had two children, David and Eric.

Don worked for the federal government for 35 years and was an immigration officer for the majority of his career. In retirement he continued his work with new immigrants and refugees at the Calgary Catholic Immigration Society. On summer weekends, he fulfilled his dream of working on the railroad by serving as a conductor on the train at Heritage Park. Don loved people and participated in many social groups. He was an active member of the Community of Christ church, Bow Valley Model Railroad Association, Lion's Club, and the Alberta Mustangs Auto Club. He will be remembered for his love of cats, trains, and cars, particularly Mustangs. Don is survived by his son, Eric, and his granddaughter, Isobel.
